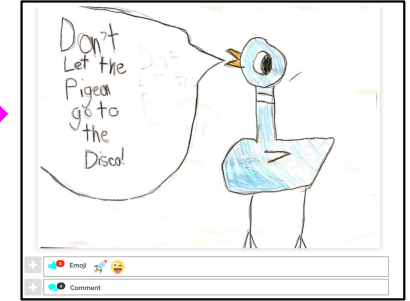
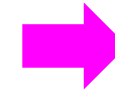
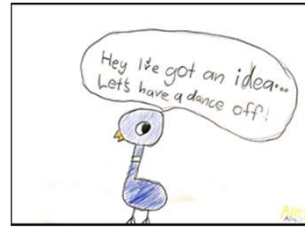
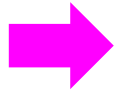


How to create a collaborative book

1. Read a quality text to your class. This could be related to a theme or topic, or a relevant event within your school.

2. Guide each student to create just one page for your own class interpretation of the book. Encourage the class to think creatively and consider the visual impact of their page.

3. Decide on the order of your pages and then create your book using the Littlescribe platform.

Teaching Tips:

- ✓ After each child has completed their own page for the book, work as a group and **manipulate the order of the pages**, demonstrating that this can result in a very different story being told. This technique would be a beneficial learning experience for older students, as they **consider their audience and the impact of their text** in greater depth.
- ✓ The fear of writing a whole story will be removed by creating a collaborative book. With **one page from each child**, you will very quickly have a joint piece of work, and your students will see their success.
- ✓ As an extension of the task, students can create their **own individual version of the book** on the same or a similar topic.
