

Everything you need to know about student accounts!

Students can use their Littlescribe account to:

- ✓ Create, edit and share their original, 'for real life' digital and print books
- ✓ Invite friends to share work in their Book Club
- ✓ Read their friends' original books and leave comments and emojis
- ✓ Explore the Megabonkeramus library for a book by a new student author
- ✓ Keep an on-going record of their progress in writing

Keeping students safe online:

Students can only create a book and place it in their Littlescribe library, until a parent connects to their account. Once a parent is connected, students can share their book with the world in the Megabonkeramus library and invite friends to their Book Club.

Creating student accounts:

- A student can be signed up by their school. They will receive their account details, and parents will be provided with a unique code to connect to their account
- A parent can create an account for their child by signing up first as a parent, then linking their child to the account.

Student account details can be used for both the mobile app and the website.



Common questions about student accounts

What can students use their account for?

Students can create, edit and publish a book into their own private Littlescribe library. Once a parent connects with their account, they can put their books into the Megabonkeramus library and other libraries within Littlescribe, invite friends to join their Book Club and print their book.

Can students in other schools see their work? There are 2 options,

1. Parents who connect – to their child’s account, enable the student/parent to control who sees each book. It can be added to the megabonkeramus Library, other students can read the selected books. **A book can be made private by the student and no other teacher or student can read this book.**
2. Parents who DO NOT connect - all sharing options are disabled, in this case only the student and teachers can view the book. Their teacher has discretion to temporarily turn on the class library for peers in their class to share writing.

What if a student forgets their username or password?

A child’s teacher can print their username and password. A parent can also set their child’s password within the platform.

What happens if a student moves into a new class?

The student account will remain active, and the teacher will move the child’s account into their Littlescribe classroom.

Is student information protected?

Yes. When a student’s book is published in the Megabonkeramus library, only the child’s first name is visible, last names are removed. Littlescribe will never sell or rent users’ personally identifiable information to third parties for any reason. We will also never sell advertising directed at students.
